### Job Summary

Supervises Detention Service Officers (DSO's) in the performance of a variety of security activities to include the control of inmates during their incarceration within the Dallas County jail system and transport to designated locations. In the absence of the Detention Service Manager (DSM), assumes full shift supervision and when the DSM is working, the DSS acts as the lead person on the shift.

### Qualifications

The minimum requirements for the exam are as follows (all required work experience must be with the Dallas County Sheriff's Department). Must have successfully maintained all State and Sheriff's Department licensing/commissioning requirements and the following:

- Served at least three (3) years as a Detention Service Officer (DSO) in Dallas County and have forty-five (45) hours of college from an accredited college or university with a grade "C" or better in each class OR
- Served at least six (6) years as a full-time Detention Service Officer (DSO) in Dallas County
