Qualifications

The minimum requirements for the exam are as follows (all required work experience must be with the Dallas County Sheriff's Department). Must have successfully maintained all State and Sheriff's Department licensing/commissioning requirements and the following:

Served at least three (3) years as a Detention Service
Officer (DSO) in Dallas County and have forty-five (45)
hours of college from an accredited college or
university with a grade "C" or better in each class OR
Served at least six (6) years as a full-time Detention
Service Officer (DSO) in Dallas County

Candidates must meet all minimum eligibility requirements by the close of the registration period, No exceptions will be made
