JOB SUMMARY:

Supervises Detention Service Officers (DSO's) in the performance of a variety of security activities to include the control of inmates during their incarceration within the Dallas County jail system and armed transportation of inmates to designated locations. In the absence of the Detention Service Manager (DSM), assumes full shift supervision and when the DSM is working, the DSS acts as the lead person on the shift.

- Valid Texas Driver's License with a good driving record
- Must possess an Intermediate peace officer proficiency certificate from (TCOLE)
- A copy of college transcript(s), if applicable
 A copy of your DD214, if military experience is going to be substituted

QUALIFICATIONS:

The minimum requirements for the exam are as follows (all required work experience must be with the Dallas County Sheriff's Department). Must have successfully maintained all State and Sheriff's Department licensing/commissioning requirements and the following:

- Served at least three (3) years as a Detention Service Officer (DSO) in Dallas County and have forty-five (45) hours of college from an accredited college or university with a grade "C" or better in each class <u>OR</u>
- Served at least six (6) years as a full-time Detention Service Officer (DSO) in Dallas County

Candidates must meet all minimum eligibility requirements by the close of the registration period
