IMPORTANT NOTICE


Effective June 1, 2023, Justice Court Precinct Four Place One will implement MANDATORY E-FILINGS of ALL cases. Paper filings will no longer be accepted after May 31, 2023.

All Pro Se litigants (parties not represented by an attorney) and attorneys will be required to submit new Eviction, Small Claims, Debt Claims, and any subsequent case filings and any other responses via E-file Texas Self-Help or E-file Texas.

Any litigant not having online computer capabilities will have access to the computer kiosk in the Justice Court office/lobby. Any filings not configured for e-filing in E-file Texas or E-file Texas Self-Help must be submitted in person.

Effective March 4, 2026 - Exceptions to mandatory E-filing - Appeals for all cases, and Immediate Possession Bonds must be filed in person.
