**SUMMER 2026 COURT INTERNSHIP**

If you're interested in getting first-hand experience with the local court and justice system, apply today for the Dallas County Justice of the Peace 4-2 Court Internship.

**INTERNSHIP DETAILS**

- The internship will last for eight weeks during Summer 2026.
- Open to high school juniors or seniors and/or local college students.
- Internships would be part-time (1-3 days per week depending on schedule)
- The internship program would consist of the following:
  - *Daily Tasks and Responsibilities:* Interns will assist court clerks with basic administrative functions such as making copies, filing, and assisting with cases.
  - *Weekly:* Interns will have the opportunity to sit in on court hearings and take notes. Post hearing, students will meet with Judge Moreno to discuss any questions they have regarding the judicial process.
  - *Bi-weekly:* Interns will have lunch with Judge Moreno and other city and county officials to discuss their roles in the community, particularly with the justice system (i.e. Constable, City Council, School Board).
  - *Throughout internship:* Interns will work on either an essay or presentation to present to Judge Moreno and staff during their completion ceremony regarding their experience and overall thoughts of the justice system.

**SCHOOL CREDIT:** The court internship is part-time (approximately 20 hours per week) and unpaid. However, students can earn community service or class credit depending on the school's policies.

**Summer 2026 INTERNSHIP TIMELINE:**

- April 1, 2026 – Application Opens
- May 1, 2026 – Application Closes
- Week of May 4, 2026 - Review Applications and Set up Interviews
- May 11 – May 22, 2026 - Conduct Interviews
- Week of May 25, 2026 – Send Decision Letters
- Week of June 8, 2026 - Internship Begins
- July 31, 2026 – Internship Ends
