

DALLAS COUNTY JUSTICE OF THE PEACE 4-2 OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE FILING PROCEDURES

Upon filing, the Petitioner will need to attach to petition proof of valid insurance and a copy of their official driving record. The driving record may be obtained through the Texas Department of Public website at http://www.txdps.state.tx.us/DriverLicense/driverrecords.htm and click on "Driver Records."

Petitioner will file the completed Occupational License petition (attached), proof of valid insurance (SR-22), a copy of an official driving record, a copy of their driver's license or identification card, and the \$66.00 filing fee.

Once the petition is filed, along with the appropriate filing fees and documents, the petitioner may request a hearing.

If the license is granted the Petitioner will need to get a cashier's check or money order made payable to the Texas Department of Public Safety for the issuance of a license. (NO CASH/NO CHECKS) You will also need to complete an SR-37 which is attached. The amount of the money order depends on how long you need the license for \$10.00 for one year and \$20.00 for two years.

Petitioner will also need money to pay for certified copies of the order granting occupational driver's license. Typically this costs approximately \$5.00, it's best to pay for this in cash.

Petitioner is NOT ELIGIBLE for an OCCUPATIONAL DRIVER LICENSE if driving privileges were lost:

- Because of a mental or physical disability;
- For failure to pay child support;
- And you need to drive a commercial motor vehicle;
- Because you received two ODL's in the past 10 years after a conviction; or,
- Because you have a "hard suspension" waiting period due to a prior DWI arrest or conviction.

OR IF:

- The judge thinks you do not have an essential need; or if
- The judge is worried about public safety
