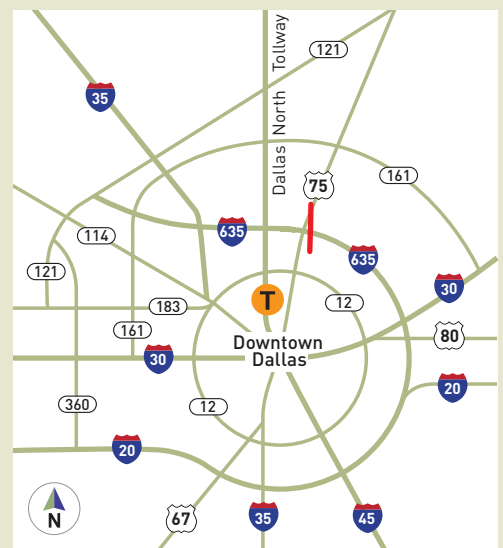


The 3.1-mile Cottonwood Trail provides a critical connection between the Preston Ridge Trail and the White Rock Trail. With this connection, it is possible to travel from the City of Dallas' far northern boundary with the City of Plano to the edge of downtown Dallas – a distance of over twenty miles – without the need of a car. The trail includes an impressive section, built by TxDOT underneath the massive "High Five" highway interchange at I-635/Central Expressway, and a handsome series of bridges and plazas as it approaches the White Rock Trail.
