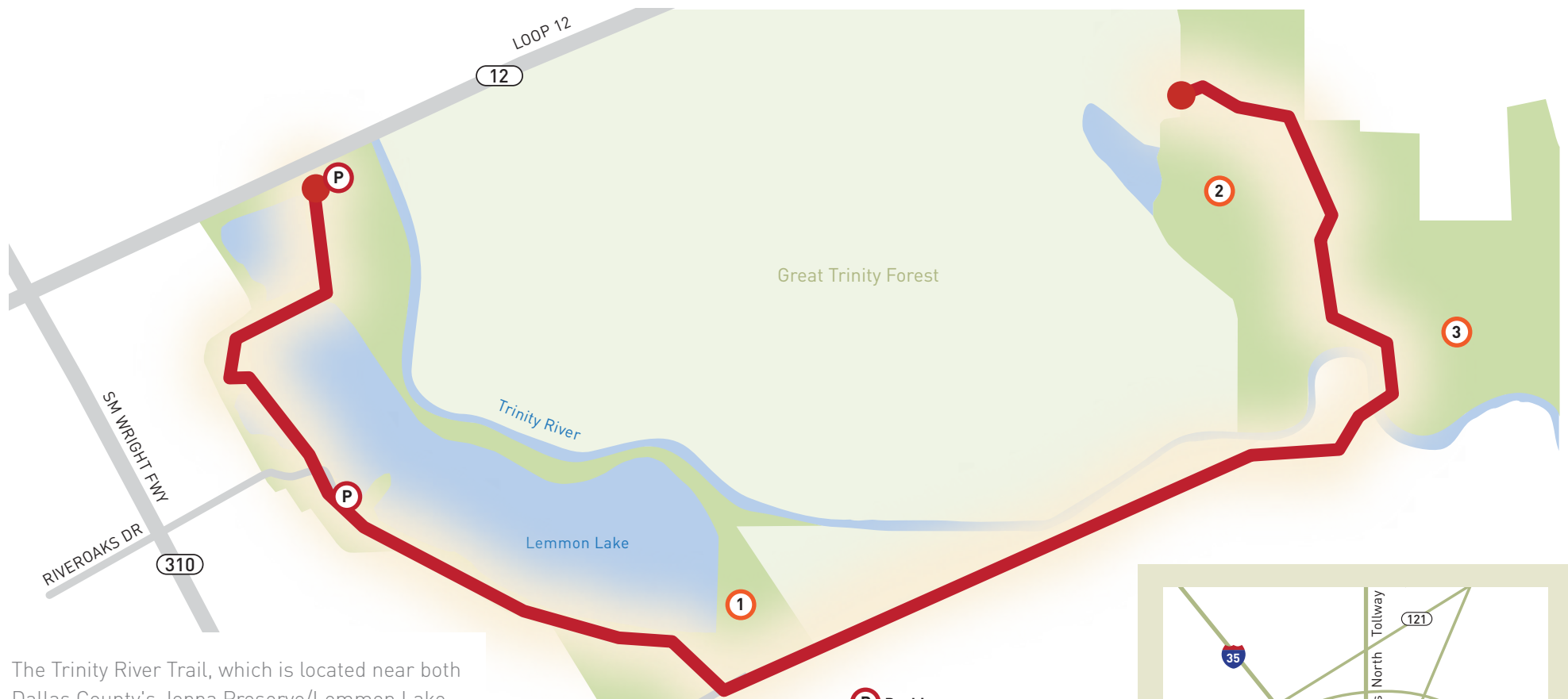




Trinity River Trail

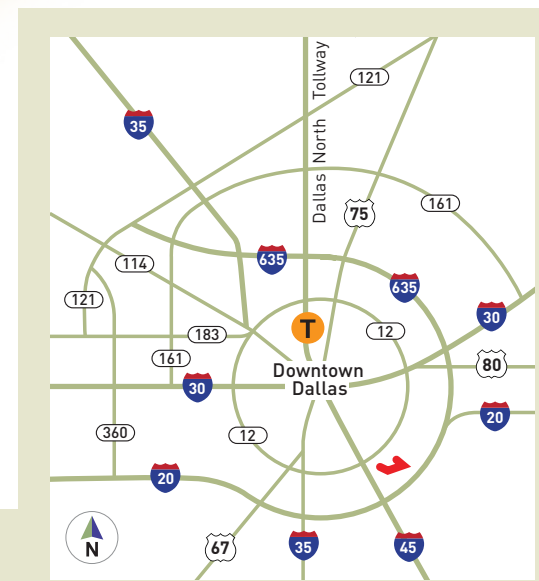
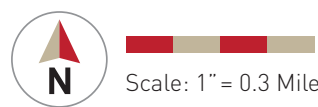

The Trinity River Trail, which is located near both Dallas County's Joppa Preserve/Lemmon Lake and the Trinity River Audubon Center, currently has a length of about 4.5 miles. This twelve-foot-wide trail is the beginning of what is anticipated to be an extensive trail system along the Trinity River. The trail already offers scenic views of both Little Lemmon Lake and Lemmon Lake which are popular stopping points for migratory birds. Parking areas are available at the Little Lemmon Lake entrance off of Loop 12, at the main Joppa entrance off of River Oaks, and at the Trinity River Audubon Center at 6500 Great Forest Way.
