**ADDENDUM #1
IFB 2026-013-7098 VEHICLE TOWING SERVICES**

Whereas,

By way of this addendum, Answers to questions received prior to the questions deadline are as follows:

Q1: Do I still need to fill out the DALLAS COUNTY Subcontractor intent form in order to bid?

A1: In order for a bidder's proposal to be considered "responsive", all SBE forms must be signed and completed in their entirety (even if the prime contractor is not utilizing any subcontractors).

Q2: will I the prime need a storage facility?

A2: We would only require quarantine parking for damaged EV power packs. The regulation is 4 meters from any other vehicle or structure.

Specification document has been updated with the following information.

1. Section II Specification 1 was updated to include electrical vehicles requiring flatbed towing.
