- I. <u>Call to Order</u>: John Dornheim, Chair called the meeting to order at 2:01 p.m.
- II. <u>Certification of Quorum</u>: Quorum was established by John Dornheim, and certified by Glenda Blackmon Johnson, RWPC Manager.

#### III. Introductions/Announcements:

- Auntjuan Wiley announced that The Wellness Roundtable has resumed meetings virtually. The meeting will be conducted from 11:00 12:30 on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of each month. He requested to be contacted to obtain the virtual meeting information.
- Due to COVID-19 Restrictions, The AIDS Walk South Dallas 2021 Event will be hosted June 26, 2021, in observance of *National HIV Testing Day*. The hope is to prompt PUSH Testing and to offer the COVID Vaccine during the walk.
- Helen Zimba announced that AFIYA enter will Host a Facebook event 3.10.2021 from Noon 1:00 pm; and she will forward the announcement flyer to support staff for distribution.
- The office of support announced the coordinator vacancy posting; and encourage interested parties to apply on the Dallas County website.
- IV. <u>Approval of February 3, 2021 Minutes</u>: Helen Zimba motioned to approve the minutes. Auntjuan Wiley seconded the motion. The motion passed.

#### V. Office of Support Report:

RWPC membership, 33 seats 19 seats are filled. 42% of the membership is non-aligned consumers. Three mandatory seat categories: State Medicare/Medicaid; recently incarcerated; and federally recognized Indian Tribes. The RWC is seeking women of Color/Transgender/Youth/Hispanic and Indian Tribe representation. Discussed the standing committee seat status.

- 1. Allocation Committee (15 seats): 7 members (8 seats open)
- 2. Evaluation Committee (15 seats): 10 members (5 seats open)
- 3. Planning & Priorities Committee (15 seats): 7 members (8 seats open)

- 4. Consumer Council Committee (20 seats): 15 members (5 seats open)
- 5. Needs Assessment Committee (25 seats): 11 members (14 seats open)
- MEMBERSHIP REFLECTIVENESS: At the end of 2019 the State reported 24,076 People Living with HIV
  - The 1st group impacted with the highest numbers is Blacks at 10,111 or 42% representation; the RWPC membership consists of 19 people of whom 10 are Black with representation at 53.00% reflectiveness.
  - The 2nd group impacted with the next highest numbers is White at 6,598 or 27% representation; the RWPC membership consists of 19 people of whom 6 are White with representation at 31.00% reflectiveness.
  - The 3rd group impacted with the next highest numbers is Latinx/Hispanic at 5,839 or 24% representation; the RWPC membership consists of 20 people of whom 3 are Latino/Hispanic with representation at 15.00% reflectiveness.
- VI. Leadership Report: John Dornheim, Chair established the platform meeting etiquette and made general announcements regarding access to Emergency Housing Assistance Program; Comprehensive Energy Assistance Program; the HIV Taskforce, Dallas County Fast Trace Cities, COVID-19 Updates and vaccine announcements on the Dallas County website <u>https://www.dallascounty.org</u>; RWPC new membership Orientation Videos; candidate interviews; and recruitment efforts. And the RWPC Leadership's invitation to participate with the CHATT Learning Collaborative.

John Dornheim, Chair opened the discussion regarding the FY 2021 Leadership/Standing Committee Member Virtual Training agenda. He reported that he extended an invitation to Venton Hill-Jones to provide an HIV Taskforce update and to Yolanda Jones to be a present regarding the Provider Network. He is awaiting a response from Venton Hill-Jones and Yolanda has agreed. Auntjuan Wiley, Vice-Chair recommended that the New Member Orientation Handout material be updated and aligned with the previous year's Handout and the Ryan White 101 Presentation. The members agreed on the New Member Orientation Agenda draft presented for discussion and projected April 14, 2021 to host the Orientation.

VII. <u>Administrative Agency Report</u>: Sonya Hughes reported that there AA received the Part B Award. The contract states level funding however the State has indicated that funding cuts are forthcoming. The stated has moved the Spend Down until June 2021 in efforts to reach out to clints who were denied due to the Spend down. Also, the AA has applied for Part C Capacity Building Grant funding to purchase the E2MyCare Portal. If approved the AA will partner with RDE to roll out the E2MyCare Portal to allow consumers to engage in care. During the call with the Project Officer, we learned that HRSA has waived the Unobligated penalty for this year and next. The AA has applied for CARES Act funds to purchase PPE supplies.

The Executive Committee interviewed one (1) candidate for standing committee appointment. The committee unanimously assigned Kevin Davis to the Consumer Council Committee and recommended him for the Ryan White Planning Council membership. The committee closed the Executive Session at 3:11 p.m. and reconvened the Executive meeting.

The Ryan White Planning Council (PC) endorsed the FY 2021 allocations from calendar year 2020 as recommended by the Allocations Committee prior to the award being received; the Allocations Committee affirms receipt of the actual (*Partial*) award for FY 2021-2022 Formula and Supplemental and carryover grants to the Dallas EMA.






