- I. Call to Order: John Dornheim, Chair, opened the meeting at 2:00 p.m. and called the meeting to order at 2:01 p.m.
- II. <u>Certification of Quorum:</u> Quorum was established by John Dornheim, Chair, and certified by Logane Brazile, RWPC Coordinator.
- III. Introductions/Announcements: Helen Turner made the following announcements:
 - There are remaining scholarships for women living with HIV to attend the Grace Project Conference from April 29-31, 2022. Those interested should visit www.graceproject.org to apply for the scholarship.
 - On Thursday, April 21, 2022, the Texas Strikeforce meets with Imelda Garcia to discuss unresolved issues regarding Take Charge Texas from the previous meeting with the Department of State Health.
 - On Friday, April 22, 2022, there will be a meeting with the ABI media campaign to gather feedback from community voices regarding ending the HIV epidemic.

Donna Wilson, CCC Chair, announced the Afiya Center would be hosting its 9th annual "Get Tested, Grab a Bite" on June 27, 2022, from 11 a.m.-4 p.m. at Glendale Park. The Afiya Center is currently looking for event vendors, volunteers, or donations. Vendor applications can be requested from Donna Wilson.

Jocelyn Rodriguez, Program Monitor, introduced herself to the committee, stating that she is happy to be at Dallas County and looks forward to meeting everyone in the future.

- **IV.** Approval of March 15, 2022, Meeting Minutes: The motion to approve the Needs Assessment Committee minutes was made by Sattie Nyachwaya, seconded by Lionel Hillard. The motion passed.
- V. Office of Support: The Needs Assessment Committee membership = 25 seats; 13 members and 12 vacancies; RWPC membership = 33 seats; 23 members and 48% non-aligned members.
- VI. <u>FY 2022 Needs Assessment Strategic Planning/ Survey Question Review</u>: Logane Brazile, RWPC Coordinator, initiated discussion of the FY 2022 Needs Assessment Question Review. The latest working draft of the Needs Assessment was shared through screen share. This document included the following revisions:
 - Re-worded questions,
 - Added answer choices,
 - Minutes for estimated survey completion
 - Categorized questions.

John Dornheim, RWPC Chair, suggested utilizing a Spanish-speaking staff member to translate the survey for inclusiveness.

Next, the committee received an update regarding the current progress of the FY 2022 Needs Assessment. The Planning

Council recently received the Evaluation Committee Composition Form from Purchasing, noting the ten evaluators determined to possess sufficient expertise in the operations of the departments affected by or benefit from using the goods or services to be procured. Vendors can now submit their proposals, and information is being prepared for submission to the chosen vendor at the appropriate time.

- VII. EHE Updates: Logane Brazile, RWPC Coordinator, reported on Tuesday, April 12, 2022, the Diagnose Work Group began reviewing a Needs Assessment survey for people not living with HIV that was initially conducted in Arizona. The Arizona survey was chosen as it had previously undergone multiple rounds of community feedback. The group went question by question and collected feedback, recommendations, and notes for the consultant to review once they were on assignment. Forty-eight questions were completed and will continue review in the Prevent Work Group on Wednesday, April 27, 2022, @ 11 a.m.
- VIII. New Business: Jasmine Sanders, RWPC Planner, announced that the Planning & Priorities Committee meeting on April 20, 2022, will be a joint meeting with the Consumer Council Committee. There will be a presentation regarding the FY 2022 Priority Ranking Process.
