- I. <u>Call to Order</u>: John Dornheim opened the meeting at 2:00 pm and called the meeting to order at 2:06 pm.
- II. <u>Certification of Quorum:</u> Quorum was established by Helen Zimba, Chair, and certified by Glenda Blackmon-Johnson, RWPC Office of Support.
- III. <u>Introductions/Announcements:</u> Glenda Blackmon-Johnson, Office of Support, announced a World AIDS Day event at Dallas County Health and Human Services building on December 1, 2022. Participants can contribute a design for the World AIDS Day quilt that will hang inside the building. Sonya Hughes, AA, announced the CQM has been working on a poster symposium to showcase the sub-recipient's Return

sonya Hughes, AA, announced the CQM has been working on a poster symposium to showcase the sub-recipient's Return to Care project outcomes. The Office of Support, alongside the Administrative Agency, will be hosting a quilting activity on December 1, 2022, in honor of World AIDS Day. Due to the concerns brought forth regarding catering decisions, the controversial entity will be excluded from the event.

- IV. <u>Approval of October 18, 2022, Meeting Minutes:</u> The motion to approve the Needs Assessment Committee minutes was made by Helen Turner and seconded by Sattie Nyachwaya. The motion passed.
- V. <u>Office of Support:</u> The Needs Assessment Committee membership = 25 seats; 16 members and 9 vacancies; RWPC membership = 33 seats; 25 members and 33% non-aligned members.
- VI. <u>FY 2022 Needs Assessment Project Planning and Updates</u>: Michael Hager, Needs Assessment Consultant, updated the committee, referencing his most recent Planning Council update. He noted that an issue with incentive card distribution has delayed the survey initiation; however, the team is working on a solution. The review and finalization of the Spanish translation are taking longer than expected. All key informants are ready and have identified their initial seed sources. Katrina Balenkov, Needs Assessment Consultant, reported the need to identify assistants who are also community members of limited access areas.

Chris Adkins reviewed the potential Dallas seed sites for the Needs Assessment survey, including FQHC or behavioral health service providers.

- Survey skip logic
- Data mapping
- Transmission networks
- COVID-19 population migration

VII. <u>EHE Updates:</u> Miranda Grant, EHE, made the following announcements:

- The Integrated Plan Workshop input meetings are taking place this month; those who need an invitation should email Miranda Grant at <u>Miranda.Grant@dallascounty.org</u>
- Responses to the Integrated Plan are due November 15, 2022. Community Solutions will compile these recommendations and have a final document on December 1, 2022.
- EHE is currently working on a "Tell Your Story" video campaign. Information regarding location and date is forthcoming.
- A regular schedule for updating the Integrated Plan + monitoring/ implementation will be established once the Needs Assessment concludes.
- HRSA will be conducting a site visit on the EHE program. The Zoom meeting link for the community meeting on November 30, 3033, will be sent in the coming days.

IX. <u>Adjournment:</u> John Dornheim called for a motion to adjourn. Helen Turner made the motion. Helen Zimba, Chair, seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 2:44 pm.
