

The Northeast area includes the Dallas and Sherman-Dennison HSDAs.

Dallas HSDA Counties: Collin, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Hunt, Kaufman, Navarro, and Rockwall


Sherman-Dennison HSDA Counties: Cooke, Fannin, and Grayson

Epi Profile


There were 19,597 people living with HIV (PLWH) in this area as of the end of 2014. This includes only people with diagnosed HIV infections with a current address in this area. People with undiagnosed HIV are not included. In 2014, 1,039 people were newly diagnosed with HIV. This does not mean they became infected in 2014, because people can live with HIV for a long time before they are diagnosed. This information comes from routine HIV disease surveillance.




Mode of Exposure



HIV Treatment Cascade for Northeast Region, 2014



78% of PLWH had at least one episode of HIV care & treatment. This means roughly 8 out of 10 PLWH were in care.



71% of PLWH had been retained in care (2 episodes of HIV care & treatment across the year). This means that roughly 7 out of 10 PLWH were retained in care.







Of the 8 out of 10 PLWH who were in care, 91% or roughly 7 out of 8 were retained in care.



59% of PLWH were virally suppressed. This means that roughly 6 out of 10 PLWH were virally suppressed.



Of those 7 out of 10 PLWH who were retained in care, 83% or roughly 6 of those 7 PLWH were virally suppressed.


HIV Treatment Cascade for Sherman Denison HSDA, 2014
