


## Treatment Cascade for Dallas EMA

Estimate of HIV+ Individuals (Known + Unknown)^*	20,221	100%
HIV+ Individuals at end of 2011*	16,561	82%
Met Need in 2011**	12,617	62%
2 Visits or Labs 3 to 6 months Apart in 2011**	7,120	35%
Achieved Viral Suppression at end of 2011***	8,739	43%

<b>HIV+ Individuals at end of 2011</b>	Number of HIV+ individuals (alive) residing in Texas at the end of the calendar year 2011.
<b>Met Need in 2011</b>	Number of PLWH who had a met need (at least one: medical visit, ART prescription, VL test, or CD4 test) in 2011.
<b>2 Visits or Labs 3 to 6 months Apart</b>	Number and percent of PLWH who had a least 2 visits or labs in 12 months, at least 3 to 6 months apart.
<b>Achieved Viral Suppression</b>	Number of PLWH who achieved viral suppression (VL test <= 200 copies/mL) at last lab visit of 2011.
