















Current Estimates

> Paving & Drainage Construction

(including Material Testing and Contingency): \$1,880,000

Design, Project Delivery, and Admin

Costs: \$555,000

PROJECT COST = \$2,435,000

- Federal (TA Set-Aside) \$1,629,000
 - ➤ 2017 Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program Awarded Project
 - > Reduced by State Admin Cost
- Local Participation (Dallas County& City of Dallas) \$806,000

SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE



DBE REQUIREMENTS FM 1382 PROJECT

Mission:

- > Increase business opportunities for Small Businesses
- Increase DBE participation in all federally funded contracts county-wide.

DBE PROGRAM

To be recognized as a DBE Firm:

- Firms <u>must</u> be certified as a DBE through the partners of the Texas Unified Certification Program (TUCP):
 - North Central Texas Regional Certification Agency
 - Texas Department of Transportation
 - City of Austin
 - South Central Texas Regional Certification Agency
 - City of Houston
 - Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority
- ➤ A for-profit small business
- Firm's majority owner's personal net worth must not to exceed \$1.32M
- > 51% owned and controlled by one or more socially and economically disadvantaged individuals

DBE PROGRAM

Requirements:

- ✓ Firms MUST complete the DBE Commitment Agreement Form
 - The contractor certifies by signature on this agreement that subcontracts will be executed between the Prime and DBE subcontractors
- ✓ Firms awarded this contract are required to meet or exceed the <u>9%</u> DBE goal
- ✓ Only DBEs certified by the TUCP are eligible to be used for the goal attainment.

DBE PROGRAM

Compliance Tracking System(B2Gnow):

- ✓ Mandatory Diversity Compliance Reporting
 - > Add all subcontractors
- ✓ Mandatory Electronic Payment Reporting
 - Prime to enter payments to Subcontractors
 - Prompt Payments (15 days)
 - Subcontractors to verify
