





Final PS&E Completed






- > 4-lanes of new pavement (P4D)

- Sidewalk improvements
- ➤ Trail connection between Good Link Trail & Lone Star Trail
- Street lighting









TYPICAL ROADWAY SECTIONS



WILDLIFE PARKWAY TYPICAL SECTION NO LEFT TURN LANE




TYPICAL BRIDGE SECTIONS



SBE REQUIREMENTS

Mission:

Increase business opportunities for Small Businesses

➤ Increase SBE participation in all locally funded contracts county-wide.

SBE QUALIFICATIONS

To be recognized as a SBE Firm:

- ➤ Vendor MUST be certified as a SBE by one of the agencies listed below:
 - Dallas-Fort Worth Minority Supplier Development Council
 - North Central Texas Regional Certification Agency
 - Women's Business Council-Southwest
- ➤ Vendor MUST have a local presence within the Dallas County Metropolitan Statistical Area consisting of:
 - Dallas County
 - Tarrant County
 - Denton County
 - Collin County

SBE PROGRAM

Requirements:

- Firms awarded this contract are encouraged to meet or exceed the SBE aspirational goal of 40%
- Firms **MUST** submit the following SBE Forms:
 - Completed and signed <u>Good Faith Effort Plan</u>, executed by an authorized representative;
 - Completed and signed <u>Small Business Utilization Affidavit</u>, executed by an authorized representative; and
 - A signed and executed <u>Subcontractor Intent Form</u>, executed by an authorized representative (prime and subcontractor).
- Mandatory Electronic Payment Reporting
 - ☐ Allows the Compliance Officer to Validate if the Prime Contractors are Paying the Sub-Contractors on-time

SBE PROGRAM

Compliance Tracking System (B2Gnow):

- ✓ Mandatory Diversity Compliance Reporting
 - Add all subcontractors
- ✓ Mandatory Electronic Payment Reporting
 - Prime to enter payments to Subcontractors
 - Subcontractors to verify
