Happy New Year!

It is near that time of year to file your Tax Income. This year the Dallas County team has opt to post W2 online for easy access for employees. Don't fret if you aren't tech savy, we have mutliple options on optaining your W2.

Personal Online Access:

- 1. Go to https://my.adp.com and, "Get Started," to create an account.
- 2. Registration Code: DALLASCNTY-DCW2
- 3. Control number- Employee ID: Enter an "E" in front of your employee ID number. Ex: E12345
- 4. Company Code: VF9
- 5. Zip Code: Enter your HOME address zip code
- Employee's SSA number: Enter your Social Security Number
- 7. Enter your US mobile phone number for a verification code
- 8. Provide your personal email address and contact information
- 9. Save your User ID and create a password.
- 10. Go to https://myadp.com and log in to access your W2.

Electronic or Mail Copies:

- 1. Email
- Treasurer.hotline@dallascounty.org
- 2. Subject line: Specify what year W2 you are requesting & how you would like to receive your W2 (electronically or mailed)
- 3. Body of email: provide ALL the following information:

Full Name

Last 4 of Social Security Number Current Address Previous Address Photo of yourself holding your ID (Selfie holding your ID. Please make sure your face and ID are easily readable in the same photo.)
